The video is 1.2MP and better than HD quality (1290x972). The default setting is B&W video to maximize stream length and to reduce the storage size of the files. Color is optional. The streams are up to 100 seconds long.

The system uses motion detection to record "streams" of video from the sensors. For example, when a car enters a space we can record a video of that. This will allow you to capture key moments where cars may bump each other whilst parking.

The stored video streams can be connected to events in the parking space. This is useful when using the sensors for enforcement purposes. For example, you can record when a vehicle entered and exited a space and use this as evidence for overstay enforcement in time-controlled areas.
